Eduardo Anselmo de Castro graduated in Civil Engineering at the University of Coimbra. He obtained a Master's Degree in Human Geography, and Local and Regional Planning from the University of Lisbon, and a PhD degree in Sciences applied to the Environment from the University of Aveiro, with a thesis on Models of Regional Economic Growth.

He is Associate Professor in the Department of Social, Political and Territory Sciences, at the University of Aveiro, and was Head of the Research Center in Governance, Competitiveness and Public Policies (GOVCOPP) between 2012 and 2018.

Professor Eduardo Castro is Responsible for the Portuguese component of the Portuguese-Spanish team that elaborated the Common Strategy for Cross-border Development, which was approved at the Iberian Cimeira of Guarda, in 2020.

He is Vice-Rector of the University of Aveiro, and was responsible for Cooperation with Society, between May 2018 and October 2020.

He has been Vice-President of the Coordinating Commission for Regional Development of the Central Region of Portugal (CCDR) since October 2020.
