Frédéric Gottrand graduated in Medicine, at Lille University, in 1983. Board certified in Pediatrics (Lille II, 1988).

He obtained a Master's Degree in Physiology and Physiopathology of Human Nutrition at University of Paris VII, in (1992, a

« Habilitation à Diriger des Recherches » at University of Lille II (1996) and a PhD Degree « Thèse de Doctorat des Universités » at the same University, in 1997.

He works the University Hospital of Lille, where he is a staff member of the Department of Pediatrics, the Head of the research department, and Research Vice president of the "Directoire" (Executive Directory). He is also Professor of Pediatrics at the Faculty of Medicine, University of Lille.

Professor Gottrand is Chair of Work Package 1 "Environmental contributions to mucosal homeostasis" Institute for Translational Research in Inflammation, INFINITE Inserm U1286, and coordinates the pediatric clinical investigation center (and Clinical Investigation Center CIC-1403-Inserm) of Lille University hospital.

He is Past President of the CRBSP (research committee of biomedical and public health) of the University Hospital of Lille, and Co-chair of PedStart, a national network of clinical investigation in pediatrics (F-Crin network)

He is a member of various French and International Professional Societies, namely that of Hepatology and Nutrition (past president and past member of the Gastrointestinal committee, Esophageal atresia WP leader), and European Society of Parenteral and Enteral Nutrition, Oesophagus Workstream co-leader of ERNICA (European rare Network).

He has produced more than 600 papers published in peer-reviewed journals, 31 book chapters.
